



# QUESTION TAGS (ZAR NE?)



What are question tags??



Have you ever heard of them??

**Question tags are short questions at the end of statements used to confirm something or to find out if something is true or not**

(to su kratka pitanja na kraju rečenice koja postavljamo kako bi potvrdili nešto ili provjerili je li neka rečenica istinita ili nije)

**This is going to be easy, isn't it??**

A POSITIVE STATEMENT HAS GOT A NEGATIVE QUESTION TAG

e.g. This **is** boring, **isn't** it?

A NEGATIVE STATEMENT HAS GOT A POSITIVE QUESTION TAG

e.g. This **isn't** fun, **is** it?

WHEN THE VERB IN THE MAIN SENTENCE IS IN **PRESENT SIMPLE** WE  
FORM A QUESTION TAG WITH **DO / DOES**

e.g. You **like** football, **DON'T** you?

She **doesn't play** tennis, **does** she?

WHEN THE VERB IN THE MAIN SENTENCE IS IN **PAST SIMPLE** WE FORM  
A QUESTION TAG WITH **DID**

(He **liked** football, **DIDN'T** he)

Verb TO BE (am, is , are / was, were) - remains

e.g. You **ARE** happy, **AREN'T** you?

We **WERE** at school, **WEREN'T** we?

It **ISN'T** going to rain, **IS** it?

LETS' CHECK!

You are bored, \_\_\_\_\_?

She helps people, \_\_\_\_\_?

We lost the game, \_\_\_\_\_?

School doesn't start at 7, \_\_\_\_\_?

\*\*\*\*pazi!!

LET'S → SHALL? (Let's go, shall we?)

I AM → AREN'T I? (I'm on the 9 o'clock flight, aren't I?)

I HAVE GOT → HAVENT I? (I have got a new phone, haven't I?)

YOU HAD → DIDN'T YOU? (You had a great time, didn't you?)

DON'T → WILL YOU? (Don't use my laptop, will you?)

Let's check!
