RELATIVE PRONOUNS

(WHO, WHICH, WHERE, WHOSE)

Relative clauses tell us more about people and things

I MET A GIRL. SHE IS A SINGER.

I MET A GIRL **WHO** IS A SINGER.

LAURA WORKS WITH ME. SHE IS FROM ITALY.

LAURA **WHO** WORKS WITH ME IS FROM ITALY.

When do we use WHO? Who do we refer to?

We use who to refer to people

SHE IS A STUDENT. SHE IS ALWAYS LATE FOR CLASS.

SHE IS A STUDENT _____ IS ALWAYS LATE FOR CLASS.

THIS IS THE EXPERT. HE WORKS AT THE ZOO.

THIS IS THE EXPERT_____ WORKS AT THE ZOO.

*We can use either WHO or THAT to refer to people (that – informal, defining clause – gives essential information)

WEWENT TO A PLAY. IT WAS VERY FUNNY.

WEWENT TO A PLAY WHICH / THAT WAS VERY FUNNY.

THIS IS A MOUNTAIN GORILLA. IT IS ENDANGERED BECAUSE OF THE HABITAT LOSS.

THIS IS THE MOUNTAIN GORILLA WHICH / THAT IS ENDANGERED BECAUSE OF THE HABITAT LOSS.

THIS IS A PHOTO, I TOOK IT IN LONDON.

THIS IS A PHOTO WHICH / THAT I TOOK IN LONDON.

We use WHICH / THAT for objects, animals and ideas.

THERE IS A SEA TURTLE ______THEY RESCUED LAST WEEK.

WE HAD ICE ICREAM ______WAS REALLY TASTY!

THIS IS LUKA. HIS FATHER IS A VET.

THIS IS LUKA **WHOSE** FATHER IS A VET.

ANNA IS A FRIEND. HER SISTER IS A DOG TRAINER.

ANNA IS A FRIEND **WHOSE** SISTER IS A DOG TRAINER.

*We use WHOSE to show possession

THIS IS THE AQUARIUM PULA. THEY HELP TURTLES HERE. THIS IS THE AQUARIUM **WHERE** THEY HELP THE TURTLES. THIS IS MY HOUSE. I LIVE HERE. THIS IS THE HOUSE WHERE I LIVE. * we use WHERE to refer to PLACES THIS IS THE CENTRE ____ THEY HELP DOLPHINS.
